CCH Board Directors are responsible for providing governance to CCH administration, including establishing strategic priorities, ensuring CCH's financial sustainability, promoting public awareness of our programs, and championing the interests of the organization. This is an opportunity to:

Desired Qualifications

Full-time or part-time residency in Canmore is preferred. However, applicants who offer expertise aligned with the organization's current needs may be considered regardless of residency.



About Canmore Community Housing

Canmore Community Housing is a non-profit corporation wholly owned by the Town of Canmore and operated as an independent organization. Established in 2000, CCH provides long-term non-market rental and ownership housing for a healthy and balanced community.

CCH exists to bridge Canmore's affordability gap for local workers and residents who meet eligibility requirements. We currently oversee over 300 long-term, non-market rental and homeownership units and steward assets aggregating over \$150 million. CCH is also committed to supporting the planning, policies, research, and partnerships that enable sustainable, below-market housing across Canmore.

With the expected 2027 addition of 144 new rental homes at 100 Palliser Trail and future projects on the horizon, incoming Directors will guide the organization through a significant period of opportunity and impact.
